#### The Pew Perspective

One of the most interesting experiences during our BBC 101 seminar was hearing everyone share what their spiritual gifts were. Some people had known for a long time what their special giftings from the Holy Spirit were, and others had just recently taken an online survey to explore how God had gifted them as believers for good works in His Church. Each person around the table named different gifts or combinations of gifts: some had more visible gifts like leading and teaching while others had perhaps less obvious but just as important Holy Spiritempowered abilities to help, encourage and minister on a one-on-one basis and behind the scenes. Even for those with similar giftings, their personalities and experiences made the way those gifts were used and expressed unique to each person.

It is fascinating how God has brought fellow believers together at Barnesville Baptist with such a wide range of spiritual gifts to complement and strengthen one another and the congregation as a whole to accomplish more than any one of us could achieve by ourselves. The Apostle Paul's words to the church in Corinth came alive with meaning for us at BBC as we talked about our spiritual gifts: "There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. There are differences of ministries, but the same Lord. And there are diversities of activities, but it is the same God who works all in all" (I Corinthians 12:4-6). Our discussion on spiritual gifts was preceded by a talk on the Great Commission and the functions of a New Testament church, so the ways in which spiritual gifts were needed to engage effectively in a healthy and balanced mix of evangelism, discipleship, ministry, fellowship, and worship were very clear.

Another benefit of the BBC 101 seminar was hearing different people speak about their roles and responsibilities in the church. Each of us only sees just a portion of all that it takes for the full range of ministry and activity that occurs. We might assume that things are somehow just taken care of so our services, activities, and meetings can go on. However, there are many different members of the congregation who contribute their time, talents, and treasure in varying ways, before, during, and after events, all to honor the Lord and further His Kingdom's work. Some have formal positions and others are just willing volunteers who are happy to contribute and participate.

The BBC 101 seminar was designed for new attenders and believers, but I think that those of us who are long-time members would benefit from a time of sharing with and learning from one another. Each of us has a story to tell and a perspective about God's work at BBC that is unique and would bless everyone else to hear about all that God is doing in our congregation. I would encourage everyone to attend future sessions of the course.


